## Program Costs (Excursion)

- \$12.00 per student - educational program
- Adults within 1:10 adult to child ratio - free
- Accompanying adults over and above the 1:10 ratio - \$10.00 per adult
- We also offer self-guided school tours at \$9.50 per student (1:10 ratio - adults free).
